- Pursuant to Article 15 of Legislative Decree 62/2024 -

WHAT IS THE LIFE PROJECT?

The **Life Project** It is a **personalized program designed to help and support people with disabilities to achieve greater independence and participation in social life.**

The individual is the protagonist of the process and actively collaborates in defining the most useful choices for their daily life.

The Life Project is built by the individual together with social and healthcare workers and third sector organizations, working as a team.

The project uses:

- **public resources** , i.e. services and interventions that can be activated in the territory;
- **personal or family resources** ;
- **the support of third sector organizations** .

→ WHY IT CAN BE USEFUL:

The Life Project is particularly suitable when the person:

- needs more coordinated interventions (social, health, work, housing, etc.);
- encounters difficulties that limit his participation in social life;
- expresses wishes and projects that require shared planning across multiple services (e.g., independent living, job placement, social and health support, etc.).

The Life Project **can be requested at any time** by the person with disabilities or by his legal representative.

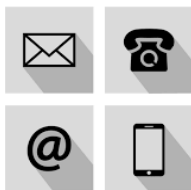
→ **It's important to contact local services for detailed information before submitting your Life Project application.**

→ IT IS IMPORTANT TO KNOW THAT:

Even without activating the Life Project It is always possible to directly request available local services (social, health, healthcare, and targeted placement), according to the procedures established by Municipalities, AST, and other local bodies.

✗ WHO CANNOT REQUEST IT:

People over 70 who are not self-sufficient and do not have a disability certification acquired before that age cannot access the Life Project (ref. art. 33 of Legislative Decree 29/2024).
